Firearms, batons, handcuffs, and other tools are often deployed to improve an officer's capacity to deter or respond to immediate threats. Who should take this course?

This CPP31318 Certificate III in Security Operations qualification is designed for people who wish to work in Manpower sector of the Private Security Industry. CPP31318 Certificate III in Security Operations with the specialisation in Armed Guard and Cash in Transit will give you the skills required to further your career as an Armed Guard, and or Cash in transit officer.

Course Entry Requirements

In order to enrol into this course, Students must hold a current Victorian Security licence. Also, following capabilities will be assessed as a part of Pre-training Review and Language, Literacy and Numeracy assessment before the enrolment or prior to the delivery of training, including Credit Transfer and RPL candidates.

What will I learn?

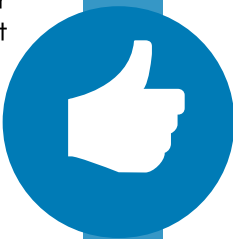
This course will provide you with a higher level of skills that will help you build sound management and leadership practices. The units in this course have been selected to prepare students for the typical expectations of major employers. The elective units will provide technical instruction in specialist areas, thus preparing students for specialised employment in cash in transit and armed guard roles.

What is a cash in transit officer?

A person who is employed to collect, transfer and or deliver cash or other valuables whilst being armed with a firearm.

What is an Armed Guard?

A person who is employed or retained to protect, watch or guard any property whilst being armed with a firearm.



Where will it lead?

Types of employment you may be able to gain once licensed:

- Armed Guard, Cash in transit
- Armed Guard at secure locations
- Discrete Armed Security Officer
- Cash Collections and Banking Duties.
- High end Retail Outlets.

How long will it take?

This qualification is available to be completed over a range of delivery modes, including weekdays and weeknights. Delivery ensures that all Victoria Police - Licensing & Regulation Division (LRD) minimum face-to-face training hours are met for the categories of Combined Armed Guard and Cash in Transit. The minimum timeframe to complete this qualification is 24 business days. Please contact us for further details.

Licensing

Upon successful completion of this qualification you will need to find employment with a licensed armed guard cash in transit security provider, said provider will then sponsor you to add the activities of Armed Guard and Cash in Transit to your security licence.
